RESOLUTION 104 - 2018

A resolution that lifts the countywide burn ban.

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners adopted resolution 65-2018 which declared that hazardous fire conditions existed; and established a burn ban on outdoor burning of combustible materials in the county; and,

WHEREAS, moderate temperatures and recent rainfall contributed to higher humidity throughout the county; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District Chiefs consulted with each other on the current fire conditions and recommended the County lift its Burn Ban; and

WHEREAS, Forest Service and Department of Natural Resources (DNR) have either reduced fire danger from moderate to low and/or already allow recreational fires in approved fire pits and do not object to the County lifting its burn ban; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners do hereby lift the burning ban established by Resolution 65-2018 in its entirety.


